Make a milk jug greenhouse (TN4)

- <u>4.</u> Plant your **seeds** in the soil.
- <u>6.</u> Put the **top** of the jug back on. **Seal** the cut edges with duct tape.
- 1. Cut around the **middle** of the jug. Do not **cut** the part under the handle.
- <u>7.</u> Place the jug **outside** in a sunny spot.


