Wildfires in BC

Level 3

We have about 2000 forest fires every summer in BC. Forest fires are also called “wildfires”.

Many hectares of forest are lost every year. Sometimes homes are lost, too.

The wildfire season starts when the forest gets dry in the spring. The fire season ends when the forests get wet from rain and snow in the fall. Wildfires happen in forests and grasslands. Summer and early fall are dangerous times for fires.

If you see a wildfire, report it.

How can I report a wildfire?

What will happen when I phone?

The operator will ask you some important questions.

1. What is your phone number?
2. Where is the fire?
3. What kind of trees are burning?
4. How big are the trees?
5. Is the fire spreading? How fast is it spreading?
6. What colour is the smoke?
7. Is anyone in danger?
