### **Jackson was not a letter carrier at first.**

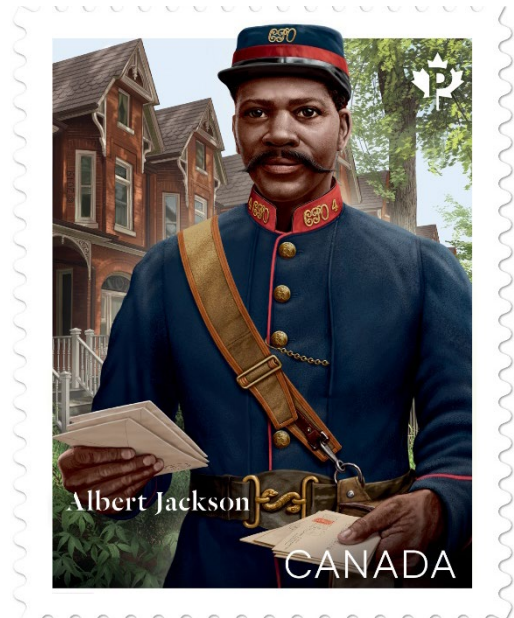
In 1882, Jackson got a job as a letter carrier.

But Jackson's co-workers would not train him. He was given a lower job as a hall porter.

The Black community in Toronto pushed the government to help.
